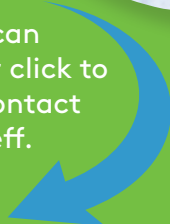

## Nematode Control

Nimitz Pro G @ 80lbs./acre March, April and May for control of Lance, Sting, Root Knot and Lesion (Irrigate 1/4" immediately after application)

Total @ 57oz./acre June, July, August and September for control of Root Knot Nematodes (Irrigate 0.1-0.5 prior to application and spray before turf has dried. Use wetting agent and irrigate after application)

Indemify @ 17.1 oz./acre October and November for control of Sting, Root Knot and ring nematodes (Irrigate with 0.1" within 12-24 hours of application)

## Fire Ant Control

Apply Taurus Trio G @ 87lbs./acre in April/May for season long control
